



Referee Liability Release
(For Referees Undertaking Testing)

There is potential risk for injury involved in training and participating in any sport. Soccer Nova Scotia has tried to create a safe and controlled environment for safe participation. The local Referee Associations have established rules in conjunction with the governing body for participation and conduct on and about the area that should be followed.

As part of the qualifying criteria with respect to acting as a referee in games or other activities under the jurisdiction of Soccer Nova Scotia, potential referees may be required to undergo certain physical testing. Tests which might be applied are undertaken as per the directives and requirements of the Canadian Soccer Association. The tests are applied under the supervision of the Soccer Nova Scotia Referee Development Committee and the various Referee Associations.

I hereby accept and acknowledge that participation in such physical testing could be dangerous and therefore I should not participate in such testing if I am aware that it may create a risk to my health and/or I should discontinue any such testing if I have any concern that carrying on will create a risk to my health.

I confirm I have read the above provisions and by signing below I acknowledge having done so and that I understand and appreciate the potential risks set out.
